

## **Announcing Docutek ERes v5.2.02**

### **INTRODUCTION**

Docutek is happy to announce the v5.2.02 update for Docutek ERes! Please see below for a complete description of the changes included in this update.

### **SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**

- Created a windows service that will automatically check on any pending CCC Connect orders once a day. When new information is found about an order then information will be updated in the Docutek ERes database and an email alert will be sent to the person who placed the order, as well as the people specified in the email alerts section of the system configuration screen.
- Added vertical and horizontal scrolling to the datagrid. This allows permanent access to the add/modify/delete control buttons, and also allows you to select many columns of data without the content running off the screen.
- You can now click anywhere within a row in the datagrid to select/deselect the checkbox for that row.
- Fixed a problem with long messages running off the page within the discussion board area of the coursepage.
- Fixed a problem that caused long URLs in a news announcement to break the formatting of the announcement panel on the homepage.
- Added the normal search and display options to the document management screen of the coursepage.
- Added the option to show the document's persistent URL and folder path within the document management screen of the coursepage.
- Added the "approval status" option to the copyright transaction create/modify screen so that you can change approval when updating copyright.
- Improved the processing within the popup "print screen" window.
- Removed the extra line-break from the end of the files generated by MARC Record Writer; this was causing warnings when the files were imported into some catalog systems.
- Allow customization of the system login message shown on the login screen, and when clicking on the page management tab of a coursepage.
- Fixed a problem that occurred when trying to login to the CCC Connect feature with an email address over 25 characters long.
- Improved the layout of the preview email screen by removing fields that were not being used.
- Created a nicer looking default coversheet for DocuFax Direct.
- Added more error handling to the DocuFax service, so that invalid TIFF files will not cause problems with fax processing.

The following items were originally included in Docutek ERes v5.2.01b:

- Redesigned the interface for the "Statistics Reports" screen, making it much easier to use.
- Added cache support for included JavaScript files, which reduces the overall page size and lessens page load times.
- Added country/region information to the address fields for both the "account" and "publisher" objects to help support internationalization.
- The CCC Connect feature can now be disabled via a private option on the system configuration screen.
- All pages are now being set to use UTF-8 encoding to allow support for additional character sets in the page.
- The currency symbol used in the system can now be customized to allow for values other than the U.S. dollar.
- It is now possible to set the current culture for the website, which will control how dates, times, calendars, currency, and numbers are entered and displayed.
- The date entry fields have been updated to use a localized, non-ambiguous entry format.
- Fixed a problem with the "Go Back" link on the copyright screens that could cause you to be taken to the wrong page.

### **INSTALLING THE UPDATE**

**\*\*Docutek strongly recommends you verify that you have a current backup of the Docutek ERes software before you apply any updates to your server.\*\***

To install this update please ask your server admin to run the "WebUpdate - ERes" program from the server desktop. If you receive a warning message during the download please wait a minute and try once more, as the download servers may be busy. Once you have run the update it's a good idea to run "WebUpdate - ERes" until you will see a message that says "no sites will be updated"; this shows that your system has received all available updates. Please note that there will be no downtime during this update, but if you are prompted to reboot you must do so immediately. If you need help, or would like to request the update be applied to your hosted system, please use the link at the bottom of this email to contact Docutek support.
