

Announcing Docutek ERes v5.3.01

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INTRODUCTION

Docutek is happy to announce the v5.3.01 update for Docutek ERes! Please see below for a complete description of the changes included in this update.

SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

- ERes now supports integration with the Unicorn library catalog system. [DOE-44], [DOE-45], [DOE-46], [DOE-76], [DOE-43]
- Allow users to export the "statistics report" data from the system like they currently do on the various admin screens. [DOE-67]
- When linking into a document from an external source show the course info and document title on password prompt screen. [DOE-37]
- Allow people to display/search the "date created" field on the "Copyright Management" screen. [DOE-38]
- The news announcement "title" field has been updated to allow HTML. [DOE-50]
- Users can now delete permission request letters from the system. [DOE-51]
- The "File size" property has been added to the list of display options on the "Documents & Copyright" screen in Page Management. [DOE-59]
- Added title tags to all the frames within a frameset per ADA guidelines. [DOE-60]
- The system now allows for customization of the link color in the secondary header at the top of the screen. [DOE-62]
- Replaced all references to "Web/OPAC Link" in the system with the more general "Web Link" label. [DOE-63]
- Improved the formatting of the "print" frame by padding the content frame, adding a left-hand margin to the display. [DOE-65]
- The Docutek Support account now has greater control over the system CSS file via the configuration screen. [DOE-66]
- The Docutek Support account can now modify the year dropdown list using the system configuration screen, custom list tab. [DOE-70]
- Fixed a problem that could cause an error when running a copyright charge report, grouped by year. [DOE-48]
- Improved the homepage layout and CSS so that the homepage would not resize on-click in FireFox. [DOE-58]
- Files attached to a document via the DocuFax Direct process are now being represented in the "file size" display on the coursepage. [DOE-64]
- Updating an instructors name in the account management section did not update the coursepage with the new name information; this has been fixed. [DOE-69]
- Changed the way email is sent from within the system, so that it will conform to the 1000 non-breaking character limit required by some mail servers and the SMTP standard. [DOE-73]
- Fixed a problem that could cause documents added to folders on the coursepage to show up in reverse time-order. [DOE-77]

- Allow caching of the JavaScript include file to improve system performance and reduce the total number of requests for the file. [DOE-81]
- Updated the DocuFax service so that it only scans the first page of a source file for a DocuFax barcode. Improve the error handling system and archive function to cut down on the possibility of errors in the service. [DOE-82]
- Updated the document management sequence so that document folders will not be created until they are needed, i.e. file is attached to the document. [DOE-83]
- Added a caching mechanism to the homepage to reduce number of database connections needed to display dynamic content. [DOE-84]
- Replaced all the data-set calls to the data-manager with the more efficient data-table calls. [DOE-85]
- Fixed a problem in the CCC order status update function that would cause the order only to be updated in ERes when it was invoiced/cancelled. [DOE-86]
- Added new coursepage icons and formats for various multimedia file types; QuickTime, Windows Media, and Real Media. [DOE-87]
- Added caching to the coursepage file-type information, as well as the system variables to improve performance and reduce trips to the database for frequently used pieces of information. [DOE-88], [DOE-89]
- Optimized the footer to improve page load performance. [DOE-90]
- Created a new entry script, called "coursepass", that will be used to handle the copyright disclaimer and the password prompt for the coursepage. [DOE-91]
- Added new options to the system configuration page that allow you to select round or square corners for the system panels and tabs. [DOE-92]

INSTALLING THE UPDATE

****Docutek strongly recommends you verify that you have a current backup of the Docutek ERes software before you apply any updates to your server.****

To install this update please ask your server admin to run the "WebUpdate - ERes" program from the server desktop. If you receive a warning message during the download please wait a minute and try once more, as the download servers may be busy. Once you have run the update it's a good idea to run "WebUpdate - ERes" until you will see a message that says "no sites will be updated"; this shows that your system has received all available updates. Please note that there will be no downtime during this update, but if you are prompted to reboot you must do so immediately.
