# ERes 5.5 Release Notes

This document provides information about enhancements and fixed issues in this version of the software.

## Enhancements

This section includes information about key features and enhancements in this version of the software. Features and enhancements are new additions or modifications to the software from the previous version.

## Microsoft .NET Framework

ERes 5.5 requires Microsoft .NET Framework version 2.0 or higher. The next version of ERes may require a later version of Microsoft .NET Framework. As ERes 5.5 supports .NET Framework version 2.0 as a minimum, you may want to consider upgrading to the current version of .NET Framework to be better prepared for future releases of ERes.

## NTFS permissions

Beginning with ERes 5.5, any upgrade to ERes will automatically reset the NTFS permissions for several of the ERes directories. NTFS permissions need to be reset after the update to allow access to your files. In previous versions, you would manually run the ConfigERes tool to re-establish file permissions. Because the permissions are now reset automatically during the update, if your system has a large number of files, the update process will take longer.



You can still use the ConfigERes tool to reset the NTFS permissions manually.

## Language sets

ERes 5.5 now supports multiple languages. For this version, English is the only language set available; however, you can create your own translated text strings for the interface. A new Language page (found in the System Tools & Settings section in the Administrator's Main Menu) lets you create, modify, and delete interface strings. These strings can then be saved as separate interface language sets.

## News item sort order

The sort order of the news items in the News Announcements is now sorted by date with the newest items listed first. Previously, news items were sorted with the oldest items listed first.

## Fixed issues

This section includes information about fixed issues in this version of the software. Fixed issues are reported issues that have been fixed in this version.

## Large file uploads

In previous releases, large file uploads could cause the application to crash. ERes 5.5 allows uploads up to the limit set by the administrator on the System Configuration page (limits can be set up to 2 gigabytes). However, if a user is uploading a very large document using a slow connection, ERes may time out before the upload is complete.

## MARC record creation

When creating a MARC record, sometimes "delete" or "update" records were not created as specified. In this version, ERes creates reliably creates all three types of MARC records.

## Deleting course-attached documents

In previous version of ERes, deleting a document attached to a course opened a dialog box that prompted you to detach the document from the course before you could delete the document. When you closed the dialog box, the document was deleted. In this version, ERes does not delete the document until you detach the document from the course and then use the Delete function.

## Known issues

This section includes information about known issues in this version of the software. Known issues are reported issues that either do not affect the software or have not been fixed in this version.

## Browser display

The appearance of the ERes interface can vary based on the specific web browser that you are using. This is cosmetic only and will not affect ERes functionality.
